REGULATION

- The Exhibition aims to revive the memory** of people who have been persecuted, abused, killed and/or are currently in prison for crimes of opinion, approximately from 2015 until today.
- Italian and foreign artists** who have reached the age of 18 may participate.
- The object of the exhibition** must be exclusively PORTRAITS of people whose rights have been violated.
- Instructions for participation:**
 - *The Artist *The Subject/Object of the Exhibition *Content email to be sent to 'humanrights2024@romaospita.it'*
 - The Artist ("A.") will have to select a case of human rights violation, anywhere in the world.¹
 - The case must necessarily have been disclosed in the media.
 - The Author must send an e-mail to the Secretariat of the Exhibition containing:
 - SURNAME and Name of the A. - Mobile phone and postal address;
 - SURNAME and Name of the person chosen for the portrait; country of origin;
 - PHOTOGRAPH from which the PORTRAIT will be taken;
 - 10 LINES max illustrating the case
 - For texts please use *Microsoft Word* – For images use *jpg* format.
 - Title of Work: The Title will consist of the Surname and Name of the Person chosen for the Portrait.
 - Size of the Work: ideal dimensions cm 50x70; in any case no more than cm 100x100.
 - Techniques:* all supports and techniques are allowed (watercolor, pencil, oil, digital processing, etc.) with the exception of photography, unless the photo you wish to send constitutes your own original documentation, broadcast by the media but not taken from the Internet – However, such cases will require the approval of the Exhibition Committee (Marco Fornerone, Stefano Pietra, Daniele Camiz), appointed specifically.
 - Sending Works:* The Artists' Work must be sent in reusable packaging for return, and delivered via courier or in person in via Marianna Dionigi 59, Thursday 5 December or Friday 6 December from 9 to 18.
 - Collecting Works:* The Works must be collected by the Courier or by the A. in Via Marianna Dionigi 59 in Rome, Wednesday 11 December during exhibition opening hours or Thursday 12 December 2024 from 10 to 17.30. For those who cannot, special agreements can be made with the Secretariat.

NB: No shipments are made.
 - Participation fee:* The Author must send € 30.00 (thirty) to the Iban IT48M0200805017000004755103, made out to *Chiesa Valdese Piazza Cavour Rome* – Reason: *Liberal disbursement Human Rights Exhibition 2024*. If two artists participate together with the same email, they will pay €40.00 (forty) cumulatively. The payment must be combined. For students of the Art Academies, the fee is €15.00 as long as they provide a document of proof. For security reasons, please send receipt of the payment to the Secretariat mail.
- For technical and organizational reasons**, the number will almost certainly be closed. We therefore inform you that, for admission, we shall follow the data-payment order.
- Registration implies acceptance of this Regulation** and constitutes a waiver in the event of theft or damage. The initiative is non-profit, and makes use of volunteers. The funds will be donated for the purposes of the Church.
- The names of the participating Authors** will be published in due course.
- If funds permit**, a catalog will be created.

ONLY FOR FOREIGN ARTISTS

The same Regulation applies to artists residing abroad. However, they may alternatively participate virtually by sending a photograph of the work – without glass and frame – to the email humanrights2024@romaospita.it. The following must be reported inside the photo: SURNAME, Name of the A. and country of origin; SURNAME, First name of the person portrayed and name of the country where the violation of human rights is or has been in progress. In the e-mail three lines explaining the case. For the projection, required format is: 300 dpi; W/H pixel 8000x6000/cm 70x50/inch 28x21. The photos will be projected on the wall during the opening hours of the exhibition. Fee for virtual participation only is € 15.00 (fifteen).

AWARDS and PUBLICATIONS

The top ten (10) finishers will receive an honorable mention. A three-month online showcase is foreseen for them to take place on the website www.chiesavaldesepiazzacavour.it, with the possibility of downloading a digital brochure.
